


Cisco Registered Envelope Services (CRES) - Mobile

Purpose:


Upon receiving an encrypted e-mail message from Northwestern for the first time, you must go through a one-time registration process. If you require technical support please call Cisco CRES support at 1-866-412-6113. The steps for first time registration are:

Procedure:

1. Within the secure message you received, click to download the “**securedoc_XXXX.html**” attachment and save it to a location you desire (keeping the file name as is). *Note: If you have a “Pop-Up Blocker” enabled on your browser, you will likely have to press and hold the <CTRL> key and click to download the file.*



2. Once the download is complete, click on the **Open** button when prompted or go to the file location you selected and double click to open the “**securedoc_XXXX.html**” file.
3. From the following screen below, click on the “**REGISTER**” button:



4. Complete the New User Registration and then click on **“Register”** at the bottom of the page.



6. Close the Final Step Browser window and return to your e-mail inbox.

7. Open the new e-mail with the subject **“Please activate with CRES”** in your Inbox.

- 8. Click on the “Click here to activate this account” link, within that e-mail.



- 9. Once you click on the above link, you will be brought to a page stating the following:

- 10. Navigate to the saved “**securedoc_XXXX.html**” file and double-click to open or you may go back to the original secure e-mail that was sent to you and click to open the attachment.
- 11. Enter your password then click on the “**Open**” button to view the encrypted e-mail.
